Summary:

The Mud Plant Operator role will be responsible for ensuring the facility is in safe operating condition and able to provide uninterrupted support to rig operations. Responsibilities include mixing drilling and completion fluids; loading and offloading trucks; ensuring facility is clean including pits and equipment; maintaining lube plant equipment on a regular basis and maintaining plant facilities.

- Working knowledge of P&ID's, process flow diagrams, piping and valve alignment
- Working knowledge of low pressure mud systems

- High school diploma or equivalent (GED)
- Must have previous Mud Plant or similar operations experience
- Possess a valid driver's license
- Must be a certified forklift operator, or ability to obtain certification
