Provide labor in deploying, retrieving, installing and maintaining seismic equipment. Assist in ensuring quality of line layout (properly spaced and level geophones). Capable of moving and transporting equipment. Capable of working outdoors with varying temperatures and adverse weather conditions for extended periods of time. Capable of walking distances of up to 10 kilometers. Capable of installing equipment in various natural and man-made obstacles requiring agility and flexibility of movement. Able to comprehend a variety of instructions and/or policies furnished in either on paper or verbally

## Requirements:

Must abide by all SAExploration's policies including but not limited to HSE, Drug & Alcohol and Operational Policies. Responsible for all aspects of health, safety and environmental concerns in particular work area. Workers must pass pre-employment physical and drug testing. Workers should be able to carry up to 75 lbs. of equipment and walking distances of up to 6 miles daily.

Workers must have a positive attitude and be prepared to assist as instructed by crew managers.
